2. Background

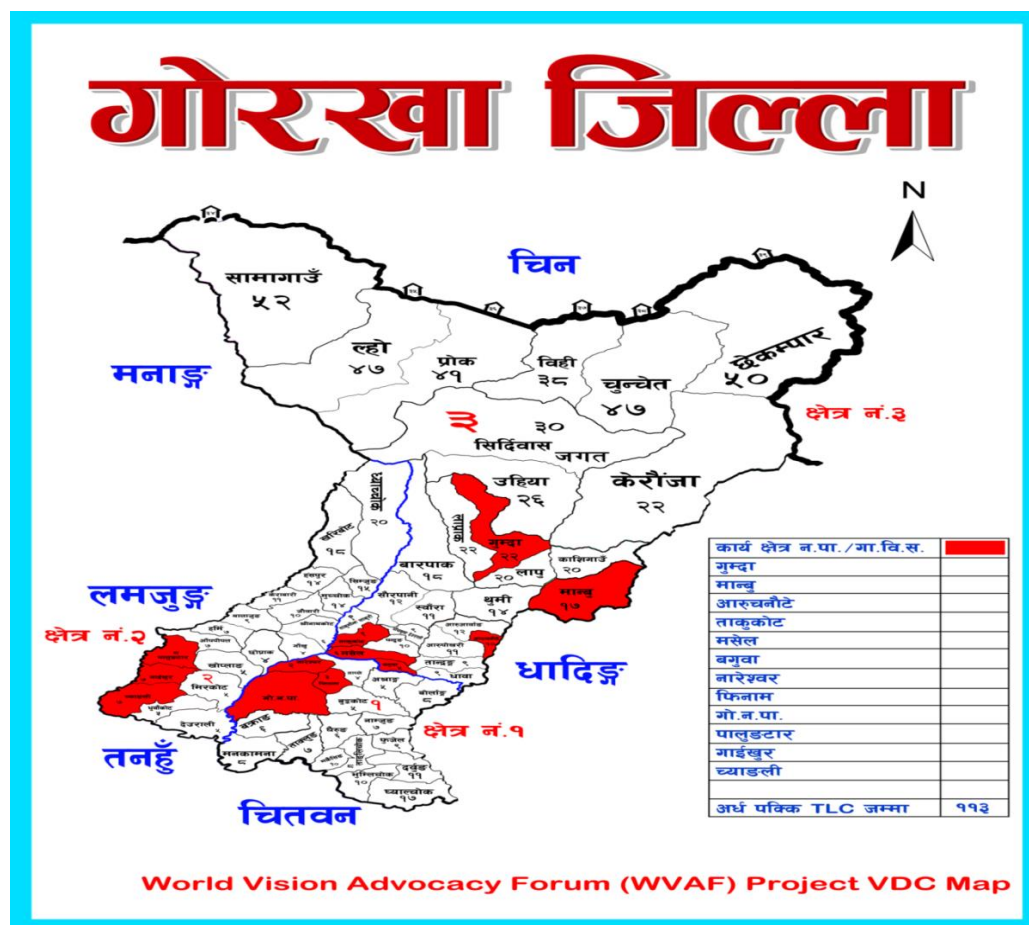
Being a Himalayan mountainous country, variable geo-climatic conditions and young geology have made Nepal susceptible to various natural disasters such as floods, earthquakes, landslides, windstorms, droughts and other ecological hazards. In the world, Nepal is in the seventh position for deaths resulting as a consequence of floods, landslides and avalanches combined and in eighth position for flood related deaths (Nepal disaster report, 2009). On an average, per day at least two people die in Nepal due to natural disaster (MOHA et al., 2008). These disaster statistics always motivate and justify the urgent need of Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) works in Nepal. Therefore, 168 countries adopted the Hyogo Framework for Action (HFA) including Nepal and so far the Government of Nepal (GoN) has assigned the national mandate towards DRR and mainstreaming the DRR in its programs. Many programs have also been initiated both from governmental and nongovernmental organizations (NGOs) in Nepal (ActionAid, 2011a; ActionAid 2011b; UNESCO 2012; Mercy Corp 2013). Raising awareness within school communities is the well implemented program in the schools. This awareness activity includes training of teachers, street drama

It is well known fact that for the developing country like Nepal, the government alone cannot take all actions for DRR in the community. Thus, the DRR education must be promoted in communities through the well groomed school teachers which are very essential to reduce disaster risk in the community and it will contribute to establish a disaster safety society. Children in Nepal continue to be perceived as mere victims of disasters rather than active agents of change who can make a real difference in terms of disaster preparedness and mitigation, both within their schools and households and within their broader communities. In line with this, and commensurate with the third section of the Hyogo Framework for Action, actors or donors of Education in Emergencies (EiE) project recognizes the need to prioritize teachers, students and ensure their participation in disaster risk reduction activities from school level.

World Vision Advocacy Forum (WVAF) is implementing Education in Emergencies Project (EiEP) in humanitarian assistance from Finn Church Aid (FCA) in Gorkha. The project aims for restoring the learning center in schools which were destroyed due to earthquake. To strengthen the quality of education, resilience and recovery at both school and community level and to

promote sustainable and impactful changes through training and orientation activities. This project mainly focused to address needs identified by education clusters. Construction of 113 Transitional Learning Centers (TLCs) and Teachers Training were the most important phase of EiE project. WVAf and FCA is working in Nine VDCs and two Municipalities intensively with 50 schools located in different part of Earthquake effected area of Gorkha district in "Post Emergency Context" with the aim and objectives. DEO Gorkha, FCA and WVAf planned to Construct 113 TLCs and trained 300 teachers and 90 SMC/PTA members in issues relevant to education in post disaster situation including cross cutting issues and other relevant topics. They trained than they will bring practical as well as theoretical knowledge and delivered to the parents, students and communities.

2. Overall Objective of the Project

- Re-functioning the Safe learning environment of the earthquake affected schools, TLCs construction, WASH restoration and capacity enhancement of SMC, PTA and Teachers on school based DRR
- To strengthen the quality of education, resilience and recovery at both school and community level and to promote sustainable and impactful changes through training and orientation activities

2.1 Specific Objectives

- To implement DRR plans by equipping schools with improving basic infrastructure facilities; disseminating DRR information through extracurricular activities mobilizing teachers, students, SMC/PTA and parents.
- To enhance knowledge, capacity and awareness of Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) education for children, parents and teachers, and .
- To provide training on DRR and Hygiene to teachers and SMC/PTA members for; raising awareness of disaster prevention, mitigation, and preparedness; and decreasing vulnerability to natural disasters

4. Working Methodology

WVAF is mainly focusing on quality services so that expected results of its initiatives will be achieved effectively & efficiently. We work efficiently in a close relation with District Education Office (DEO) District Coordination Committee (DCC) and National Reconstruction Authority (NRA).

- Initially the movement of social mobilizers to the site for the feasibility study of proposed schools for TLCs construction was done. The feasibility study of the schools were performed under the basis of school list provided by the DEO. Series of coordination meetings with concerned government agencies was the basic strategy adopted for school selection, screening the schools on the basis of need assessment feasibility study results.
- The School management Committee and Local level stakeholder were always informed and engaged during the need assessment process.
- Organised staff orientation for the familiarize humanitarian principles, INEE minimum standards and contextualize in Nepal's post earthquake context
- Organised consultative workshop in coordination with District Education Office
- Organised Teachers Training in coordination with District Education Office and other stakeholders
- WVAF social mobilizers motivated to School management Committee (SMC) Parents Teachers Association (PTA) and Local level stakeholder to be accountable for the school construction this increases the community engagement and ensures ownership over the project results.
- DEO officials participated during the conduction of Teacher's Training which ensured smooth coordination with project and government agencies.
- DEO, NRA and DDC participated in monitoring during the construction of TLCs which ensured the quality of TLCs

5. Consultative Workshop

The Consultative Workshop held at the Hotel Miracel, Haramtari, Gorkha on 4-6 August 2016, with an objective to prepare a draft of teacher training action plan for reduction the disaster hazards and Advocate for the integration of "safe school" standards and DRR curriculum into district-level education policies . The workshop was facilitated by WVAF in collaboration with DEO for the content development of Teachers Training. More than 40 participants were participated in the workshop. Executive Director of WVAF and Senior officers from FCA including DEO, Asst. DEO, school supervisors, resource persons and staff of local NGOs, INGOs from Gorkha are taking part in the workshop

The Chief district officer (CDO) of Gorkha Mr, Narayan Prasad Bhatta, inaugurated the workshop program. During the inaugural speech, Mr. Bhatta stressed the need for earthquake safety in education sector as schools are highly vulnerable. Further, he thanked WVAF, FCA and UNICEF for supporting the Government to build capacity in school based DRR which would in turn help to implement DRR activities in the schools more effectively. While the inaugural address was given by the District Education Officer (DEO) Mr. Dipendra Subedi. He also presents the government laws and policies for DRR management and quality education and its tool. His presentation include about school sector reform plan (SSRP), school sector development plan (SSDP) and display documentary of national and international disaster situation and recovery condition, responsibility of stakeholder to handled and look after disaster management. The three day workshop was divided broadly into 8 sessions. The first half started with self introduction and project introduction. Facilitator introduced the project and education in emergencies. In addition to the inauguration of the workshop all the session of the three days



workshop went into the individual session in a planned way. The Major topics in the workshop were about disaster, capacity and reduction related to school safety, capacity to reduce hazards, gender equality, disability, Vulnerability Capacity Assessment(VCA) and its role for DRR plan on immediate school conduction after disaster.

Different formal and informal discussion and consultatin with the participants, education stakeholders and presentation of DEO concluded that Gorkha is prone to multiple hazards such as earthquakes, landslides, flash floods and epidemics. The schools of Gorkha are also highly vulnerable to these potential hazards especially earthquakes, but the level of preparedness and knowledge of risk & resilience are also low. The main objective of the workshop is to build capacity of education stakeholders in implementing comprehensive school safety and disaster risk reduction. The trained professionals will be conducting further trainings for the teachers, school management committee and parents teachers association and support the schools in preparing risk management plans and enhancing disaster preparedness capacity.

6. Orientation to Staff

Re-establishing education after an emergency not only meets a fundamental right of children to education regardless of the circumstances, but also plays a critical role in normalizing the environment for children and contributes significantly to helping children overcome the psychological impact of disasters. Equally important, education provides a protective environment for children, who are more vulnerable to exploitation and abuse in the wake of emergencies.

WVAF is clearly aware that in order to complete the activities planned and achieve fruitful results, it is very important to build the capacity and understanding of our staffs working as well as our beneficiaries in the field so that they can conduct the activities smoothly. Under the activity **2.1.3 Organizations of orientation for community mobilizers**, district office Gorkha organized orientation in May 18 & 19, 2016. FCA central office team, WVAF, Executive Director and Executive Member travelled to Gorkha to attend the district level orientation. The orientation was facilitated by project manager and district education officer of FCA and all the administrative management was handled by the finance manager.

The two day orientation was divided broadly into 4 sessions. The first half in introduced the project and the “Education in Emergencies and Kit Orientation: What, Why, How?” The second



and third session went into the individual components of the INEE and EIE, and the fourth session was a discussion with different agencies (SAVE, WVI, CARE, OXFAM) who works in Gorkha in education component and District Education Office.

The overall impression of the 2days orientation on UNICEF Kit orientation, EIE, INEE and WASH component was found to be very effective as it was very much participatory and most of the invitees were present at the program. The comments, suggestions and feedback received from the participants of the program were very constructive. Most of the stakeholders of the project were present at the orientation and the project team was able to collect constructive feedback which is one of the important achievements of the program. The central level team of WVAF and FCA provided feedback and suggestions to the district staffs and coordinate in the preparation of the program.

Hence, the orientation was very successfully conducted at Gorkha. Asst. DEO Mr. Thakur Jee Tiwari thanked the project team and the organizations working for the benefit of earthquake affected school of Gorkha district. All the Resource person and School supervisor of the respective project VDC present in the meeting gave positive feedbacks and suggestions for future tie up and coordination while carrying out the project activities in the district. Altogether 32 participants attended the orientation.

The Main objectives of the staff orientation

- To familiarize and orient the Community Mobilizers with the UNICEF Education Materials.
- To involve Community mobilizers in the process of monitoring the impact of the education materials on the learners (beneficiaries).
- To orient Community mobilizers and familiarize humanitarian principles, INEE minimum standards and contextualize in Nepal's post earthquake context

7. Teachers Training

As part of the most important phase of EiE project is teachers training which aims to enhance knowledge, capacity and awareness of Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) education for

children, parents and teachers and to strengthen the quality of education, resilience and recovery at both school and community level and to promote sustainable and impactful changes through training and orientation activities. The resulting benefits can be reduced death and injuries in disaster events due to safer schools buildings, better preparedness, and increased capacity and knowledge regarding what to do in an emergency. The activities under the EiE closely align with the three commonly considered ‘pillars’ of DRR and education, namely: 1) ensuring safer schools 2) teaching and learning to increase knowledge and education and 3) education on disaster management. Based on these three pillars of DRR, WVAf and FCA in close coordination with DEO Gorkha is working in Nine VDCs and two Municipalities intensively within 50 schools located in different part of Earthquake affected area of Gorkha district on teacher training in "Post Emergency Context" with the defined aim and objectives. DEO Gorkha, FCA and WVAf trained 367 teachers and SMC/PTA members (list of participant see Annex 2) in issues relevant to education in post disaster situation including cross cutting issues and other relevant topics in 16 events. Trained teachers, SMC and PTA members delivered practical as well as theoretical knowledge to the students, parents and communities

Firstly, the project held many sensitization, orientation and talk programmes which involved various stakeholders at different levels in order to make participants aware of DRR and the importance of participatory vulnerability assessment (PVA). Training on disaster risk reduction and Hygiene was provided to teachers and SMC/PTA members for; raising awareness of disaster prevention, mitigation, and preparedness; and decreasing vulnerability to natural disasters. The Teachers training uses a mixture of lectures, small group work, and activities to convey concepts and support learning. Throughout the course participants work in small groups to complete activities and present back to the plenary. These types of activities enhance the learning and enable participants to understand and identify hazards and risks affecting their school and community and how they can reduce their vulnerability. Participants also learn how to carry out hazard and vulnerability assessments and develop greater understanding of their roles to community-based disaster risk reduction programmes and activities. Training of headteachers, teachers, school management committees and parents teachers association is crucial to enhance knowledge, capacity and awareness of DRR

to make schools in high-risk disaster areas safer. The enthusiasm and optimism of the teachers, SMC and PTA engaged in these initiatives, and well as the effectiveness of school-based DRR to promote both safer schools and more resilient communities, convinced us that further investments in school-based DRR are warranted.

The overall impression of the Teachers Training was found to be very effective as it was very much participatory and most of the invitees were presented at the program. The comments, suggestions and feedback received from the participants of the program were very constructive. They expressed sincere appreciation towards the objectives of the training. They are very pleased to be the part of the training and express their gratitude toward WVAF and FCA for being so supportive to promote DRR education. The activities designed by the project were new and different as they stated. The DEO and his staff continued to be very positive and supportive for the programme. The cooperation between the EU, UNICEF, FCA and the teachers of Gorkha are key factors for the accomplishment of this training.

8. Achievements

- Active participation of all school head teachers, teachers. SMC/PTA members in the training
- Almost all the teachers attended training for the first time in their teaching career; therefore all are equally responsible to implement their learning in school Corruption prone areas identified in infrastructure reconstruction sector in the targeted districts
- The District Education Office, Resource persons, SMC/PTA are very delighted and expressed their gratitude for starting the whole school approach training
- Capacity development of teachers to identify the possible risk, risk management, prepare school base, action plan to minimize, risk and include in SIP
- Distributed teaching and learning materials to teachers and students in 56 Schools
- Till date 110 TLCs have been completed
- Students in target schools in Gorkha are benefitting from quality educational materials and improved training practices and learning methods and have increased awareness on school safety and resilience, as well as on good hygiene and sanitation practices
- Teachers, students and communities were sensitized and oriented on disaster preparedness and securing alternative livelihoods in a post-disaster situation

Outcomes/Voice from participants regarding Teachers Training

We never used to be familiar with the vulnerability-, risk- and hazard prone areas within our school, but now, because of vulnerable capacity analysis (VCA), we are. In order to minimise risks, I think it is necessary to use DRR education to inform people about these areas. Now we can make and implement appropriate plans and programmes. Group work materials and videos shows are also effective in increasing knowledge about DRR among us.

9. Comments and feeling of teachers about training

- The teachers responded that the training was wonderful and a great opportunity for them to learn disaster Risk Reduction, Recovery and Resilience. They are very pleased to be the part of the training and express their gratitude towards WVAF and FCA for being so supportive to strengthening the capacity of school teacher to have access of disaster resilient school environment.
- Teachers enjoyed having a big group of teachers and sharing of the experiences and skills.
- Teachers realised for this programme to be worthwhile they have to show changed behaviour in their community, school and classroom.
- The different group work and activities of DRR was acknowledged by the participants.
- Teachers enjoyed the teaching technique using the real objects, classroom materials. Games along with the activities are more powerful tools to make teaching learning activities lively and effective.
- Whole teachers, representatives of SMC/PTA Training along with parents orientation programme is an essential aspect to achieve quality education so that special priority to be given to community involvement in the future



- Regular capacity building of SMC and PTA will be required for improving the awareness of DRR

10 Challenges

- It became more challenging to deliver education kit and construction site survey in the most remote areas due to difficult road conditions and risk of landslides
- Seasonal monsoons posed a significant challenge to our work by reducing road access and making it difficult to reach remote regions
- Because of the monsoon, the roads can get blocked which may result in delayed distribution of kits and delayed transportation of the construction materials.
- The main challenges faced by the project in construction work include;
 - a) short duration of the project and slow pace of implementation
 - b) ineffective coordination mechanism among donors NGO and DEO
 - c) weak organizational capacity of contractor in field based implementation activities
 - d) Poor workmanship and lack of qualified staff in construction related work
 - e) Lack of skilled labor force in the construction
- Frequently changed in the plan of donor and design of the TLCs create confusion
- Frequently changed of the working school given by the DEO has create a difficulties in implementation and timely completion

10. Lesson Learnt

- Frequent changes in the construction design have a negative impact on the project
- Sufficient time must be allotted to the planning phase of a construction project



- Members of the construction unit must acquire a good knowledge of construction procedures at the beginning of their collaboration, and expatriate colleagues should be informed of important local parameters
- Necessary technical resources must be made available to the construction unit.
- At the outset of a project, a detailed action plan should be defined. This plan must be updated as the project develops and be the basis for project monitoring and monthly progress reports.
- Planning a reasonable time must be defined at the outset. Donors and other stakeholders should avoid imposing unrealistic deadlines.
- Clear project implementation plan is essential
- Coordination and collaboration is most important aspect for achieving the objective of the program
- The knowledge accumulated in other places should be made available to those responsible for a project. The knowledge gained in a project or program must be maintained.
- Systematic planning for disaster preparedness and mitigation is needed to deal with emergency situations

Conclusion

WVAF believes that communities are principal stakeholders in local development and should play the central role in the management of the projects and activities. WVAF would like to take this opportunity to state its gratitude to those that it has worked with during the course of the project.

We would like to thank FCA for its continued support and for granting us the opportunity to undertake this worthwhile initiative, which we believe has made a valuable contribution towards earthquake affected schools and communities reducing the vulnerability of the schools and communities with whom we have worked and towards effective DRR practice in those local contexts and beyond.
